

Wentworth College in Gulf Harbour

Wentworth College was founded in 2003 and is one of the leading co-educational private schools in Auckland catering for students from Primary School through to College Year 13.

Last year, 100% of our domestic students achieved University Entrance.

Wentworth College has a long history of looking after students with exceptional Golf Talents. Any Year 1 to Year 13 student with a handicap of less than 10*, attending Wentworth College in full time education, is eligible for a Wentworth Golf Scholarship.

Flexible Study Arrangements

Wentworth is supportive of our golf students, allowing them to combine their academic studies with professional Golf training. We do allow time off school for professional lessons. Many of our golfers study at Wentworth College in the morning, and then take periods 5 and 6 off to have professional golf tuition. We also allow time off for tournaments.

School Golf Team

We have a golf team here at Wentworth College that students are encouraged to join. We enter the team in to inter-school competitions and many of our Golf students also enter private competitions through Gulf Harbour Country club.

Report Process

A monthly report is available for each player covering session information and tasks that have been assigned, and the coach's areas of development for the player and the player's progress.

About Our Golf Scholarship

For students with a handicap of less than 10*, we offer a Golf Scholarship. Included in the tuition fees are the following:

- Membership to Gulf Harbour Country Club with unlimited access to play there
- Full facility use of the chipping green, pitching green, driving range and 18 hole golf course
- 1 hour per week coaching based on 40 weeks per year (extra lessons available at discounted rate)
- Unlimited balls every day on the driving range
- Wentworth College / GHCC Golf Clothing, to be worn at all times on the course
- Secure equipment storage at the golf club
- 10% discount in Golf Shop on all balls and clothing
- 20% discount on Golf Clubs
- Golf coaching will be as a group and the student will have the ability to receive technical advice and course management advice including:
 - A practise diary to record tournament rounds, and skill testing
 - Tournament preparation drills
 - Golf fitness
 - Short game skills testing
 - Club fitting using Flight scope
 - Providing players with their golf clubs distances throughout the bag using Flight scope
