All applications must be on these official Wentworth Primary School forms. All sections must be completed. Please ensure that your name, address and contact numbers are easy to read on the forms as we need these for emergency contact and for sending School reports.

The applicant's parent must sign the bottom page of each application. Only a parent or court-appointed legal guardian may sign. The signature of an agent, relative or any other person is not acceptable. It is the responsibility of the Parent to ensure he or she understands what is being signed.

If the application is accepted, the student will be given an "Offer of a Place". This is based on a preliminary estimate and a final class placement will be made when the Student is given a series of assessments on arrival.

No application will be accepted unless the Parent agrees that the Student will live with a parent for the duration of their studies at Wentworth Primary School.

Because all the conditions of enrolment will be strictly enforced, including the Refunds Policy, please do not accept an offer of a place at Wentworth Primary School unless you have a clear understanding of these conditions.

Please ensure that all the information is complete and correct. Failure to properly complete the form may result in a delay in processing, or rejection of your application. Failure to provide correct information may result in your child's enrolment being terminated.
